3. Follow up of Action Items:

- a. No wake zone and talking on the Net Channel 71 (Clementine) Clementine will go to those in charge of the Port Authority Bonny suggested inviting top people at the Port Authority to a meeting in November to discuss our needs, their needs, and a mutual understanding - agreed
- b. Awards Night Report (Karen)52 people attended: MBYC paid for 28 & individuals paid for 24

b. Vice Commodore Report and Recommendations

The biggest issue of the Vice Commodore Cary is the fact that moorings and buoys need to be checked regularly. Good project for the summer, hardware, divers, and snorkelers needed. Each boat owner is responsible for checking his/her mooring and reporting problems to MBYC.

c. Treasurer Report and Recommendations

Current balance \$1254.83 with a check for \$185 for memberships received at meeting from Bonny and a check for \$220 imminent from Ace's One Stop for wholesale shirts (20 @ \$11 each) MBYC has purchased 50 burgees for \$35 ea. – sell for \$40 ea Purchasing a burgee requires purchasing a membership Clem recommends activating Google drive on the gmail account to make all information immediately and permanently available

e. Publicity Director Report and Recommendations

f. Membership Director Report and Recommendations

Bonny reports that total paid memberships for 2015 = 69

- 40 are boat owners, 26 currently in Majuro Lagoon
- 42 are single & 27 are couple/family memberships
- MBYC needs more new memberships & more renewals
- Bonny keeps track of memberships both alphabetically and numerically
- The most recently assigned membership # is 530
- The new plastic membership cards must be written on with a ball point pen, NOT a felt tip marker

 All Committee members should carry membership forms, collect money, and turn the money and information over to Bonny. For new members, Bonny will assign #.

Bonny should be the only member of the committee to change Contact Lists on gmail account.

g. Quartermaster and Prize Director Report and Recommendations Written Reports were presented and are attached for both Quartermaster and for Prize Director: see Reports attached

h. Race Director Report and Recommendations:

The Handicap Calculation and Race Results are posted on the MBYC website

An amendment to the report reflects the discussion on keeping a running total of participants in each event. Crew prizes should be restricted to members only.

5. Other Business:

- Bonny brought up summersailstice.com which involves sailing at dawn on June 21 each year: MBYC is in the right time zone to be the first to see dawn each year on the summer solstice. She will organize as many boats as are here and interested for the morning's sail which is good world-wide advertisement for MBYC. Burgees and other merchandize are available at www.summersailstice.com.
- Karen began a discussion of how much effort is required for the Learn-to-Sail Day and how little benefits are derived from it. The Beer Can Race is much less labor intensive and popular. Suggest holding the Beer Can Race earlier, such as November.
- It was suggested that the first race of the season serve as the anniversary of the creation of MBYC.
- How to promote memberships?
- Only crewmembers who are members of MBYC are eligible for prizes.
